

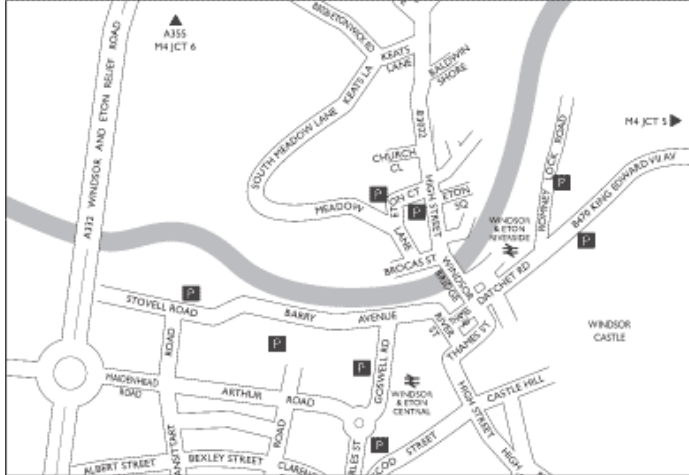

By Road:

From Reading and the West on M4

Eton, B3022. Leave M4 at Junction 6, signposted to Windsor and Eton. Take a left at the roundabout onto the A355. At the next roundabout, take the third exit to Eton, continue straight through two sets of traffic lights and turn right at the third set to Eton and Windsor (A332). Pass under the M4 to another roundabout and take the first exit to Eton. You are now on Windsor Road, which leads into **Eton High Street**. iDirect is situated on the right-hand side, opposite Eton Porny School.

From London and the East on M4

Leave M4 at Junction 5 (signposted to Slough East and Eton) and proceed along the B470, Majors Farm Road, which continues into the London Road. Turn right at the roundabout at the end of London Road and continue over the mini roundabout. At the next roundabout, turn left unto Eton Road (B3026), which continues into Pockocks Lane. Turn left at T Junction (mini roundabout) at the end of Pockocks Lane. You are now on Windsor Road, which leads into **Eton High Street**. iDirect is situated on the right-hand side, opposite Eton Porny School.

By Air:

The closest airport is London Heathrow - 20 minutes drive. Taxis available at the Airport rank are black London cabs with a minimum charge. We recommend that you book a local taxi company to collect you from the pick-up point (i.e. Sovereign Cars +44 1753 774 774) or arrange to be met in the Airport by the driver of an executive car service (i.e. 1st Class Cars +44 1628 780660). Gatwick and Luton Airports both approximately 1 hour drive.

By Public Transport - Train:

Nearest Main Train stations are Windsor Central and Windsor Riverside. Windsor Central connects to Paddington, London via Slough. Trains from Windsor Riverside connect to Waterloo in London. There is a taxi stand right outside the station buildings, however a pedestrian bridge gains access to Eton High Street directly and it is a pleasant 5-10 minute walk. Drivers must go a different route and it will take 20 minutes in a taxi.
